## Plan your travel for APEC



### Your guide to travelling during APEC 2-9 September 2007

From 2 – 9 September 2007, the Australian Government will host APEC in Sydney. This is the most significant international economic meeting ever to be held in Australia and will bring together 21 world leaders as well as thousands of delegates, support staff and media.

Hosting the APEC meetings will mean significant dignitary protection and therefore changes will be required to transport and traffic arrangements to ensure a safe and secure event.

Every effort is being made to minimise disruption to Sydney residents and businesses and to make only essential changes. However, public transport and traffic arrangements throughout the Sydney CBD will be affected. Most restrictions, changes and diversions come into place from Monday 3 September, with changes and diversions at their peak on Friday 7, Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 September.

**Friday 7 September is a public holiday for people who work in the Sydney Metropolitan area.**

# Tips for travelling during APEC

## Leave the car at home

Leave the car at home and catch public transport. Wherever possible, walk to and from train stations, bus stops and ferry wharves.

## Plan ahead

The earlier you start planning your travel during APEC, the easier it is to arrange the best way to get around using public transport. Be sure to allow plenty of time for your journey and try to avoid travelling in the CBD on 7, 8 and 9 September.

## Plan your weekend out of the City

Due to increased security arrangements in place and restricted access in the CBD, why not plan a weekend away or meet friends for dinner at a local restaurant in your suburb? For special weekend away packages during the long weekend, visit [www.visitnsw.com](http://www.visitnsw.com)

## Plan to walk in the CBD

Due to station closures, temporary bus terminals and restricted access in the northern part of the Sydney CBD, you might have to walk within certain areas. So remember to wear comfortable walking shoes if visiting the City.

## Allow extra time if using Sydney Airport

There will be significant disruptions around Sydney Airport during APEC, so please allow additional time getting to and from the airport if travelling by car. Alternatively, take the train to either the Domestic or International terminals – just 10 minutes from Central Station. Motorists travelling from the northern suburbs to the airport between 4 and 9 September should allow extra travelling time and use alternative routes, avoiding the City.

## If you see something, say something.

If you see an unattended bag, package or any suspicious activity on public transport, don't keep it to yourself. Tell a staff member or phone the Police on **000**.



Sydney Buses will service its normal routes but there will be some diversions and changed stopping patterns due to CBD road closures. All northern bus services are expected to operate as normal. Bus services on all other routes that normally terminate and depart Circular Quay, will depart frequently from temporary bus terminals, locations are shown on the map. Services to Millers Point and King Street Wharf will be diverted to operate via an alternative route.

### Explorer services

From Monday 3 September to Thursday 6 September part of the Sydney and Bondi Explorer routes will stop at alternative bus stops. These services will **not** operate from Friday 7 September to Sunday 9 September.

## APEC temporary bus terminal locations

### Sat 1 Sept – Thu 6 Sept

Temporary bus terminals will be in place for services that normally terminate and depart at Circular Quay.

#### 1. Botany Rd & Surry Hills services

Routes 301, 302, 303, 308, 309, X09, 310, X10. Depart from Castlereagh Street south of Martin Place.

#### 2. Eastern Suburbs & Randwick Junction services

Routes 311, 324-327, 333 PrePay Only, 371, 373, X73, 374, X74, 376, 377, X77, 380, 389, 391, 392, X92, 394, X94, 396, X96, 397, 399. Depart from Elizabeth Street at Martin Place.

#### 3. Pyrmont, Parramatta Road and Victoria Road services

Routes L03, X04, 435-438, L38, L39, L40, 440, 443, 470, 500-series, X00, X06, X15, X18, L20, and 501 (Circular Quay trips only). Depart from George Street opposite Wynyard Station.

#### 4. Newtown services

Routes 422, 423, L23, 426, 428, L28. Depart from Castlereagh Street north of Martin Place.

### Fri 7 Sept – Sun 9 Sept

Temporary bus terminals will be in place and some diversions will be necessary.

#### Friday 7 September

Sydney Buses will operate to a Sunday/public holiday timetable, departing from temporary bus terminals shown on the map. Routes that connect with Sydney Ferries services will operate to a Saturday timetable, except routes 238 and 538, which will operate to a public holiday timetable.

#### Saturday 8 and Sunday 9 September

Services during the weekend will operate to Saturday and Sunday timetables from temporary City bus terminals.

#### 5. Botany Road, Surry Hills & South Eastern suburbs services

Routes 301, 302, 303, 309, 310, 391, 392, 394, 396, 397, 399. Depart from Elizabeth Street, south of St James Road.

#### 6. Randwick Junction, and Route 308, 339 & 343 services

Routes 308, 339, 343, 373, 376, 377. Depart from Park Street, southern side between Elizabeth & College streets.

#### 7. William Street & Oxford Street/ Bondi Junction services

Routes 311, 324-327, 333 PrePay Only, 380, 389. Depart from College Street, between St Mary's Road & William Street.

#### 8. Newtown & Parramatta Road services

Routes 422, 423, 426, 428, 435-438, 440, 461, 470, 480, 483. Depart from Castlereagh Street, between Market & Park streets.

#### 9. Victoria Road services

Route 500-series and L20, including Route 501. Depart from Park Street, between Pitt & Castlereagh streets.

#### 10. Lower North Shore services

Routes 202, 207, 208, 263, 273. Depart from Wynyard as normal.

#### 11. Northern Beaches services

Route 100-series services, and routes 243-247. Depart from Wynyard as normal. Trips that operate to QVB and Railway Square will continue to depart as normal.

#### 12. Lane Cove, Epping Road, Pyrmont & Balmain services

Routes 252-254, 261, 288-292, 442, 443. Depart as normal from York Street at QVB.

**On Monday 10 September bus terminals and services will revert to normal as roads open.**



There will be minor changes to Sydney Ferries services during APEC.

### Friday 7 September

All ferry services will run to a public holiday timetable.

### Saturday 8 – Sunday 9 September

All ferry services will run to a normal weekend timetable.

### JetCats

JetCat services to and from Manly will **not** operate during the long weekend from Friday 7 September to Sunday 9 September.

## Harbour access restrictions

Disruptions to normal recreational harbour traffic will be minimal, though some restrictions will apply in the vicinity of Bennelong Point. Check [www.maritime.nsw.gov.au](http://www.maritime.nsw.gov.au) for more details.



## Taxis and coaches

Taxis and coaches will be allowed to travel into the precinct bounded by King, George, Macquarie and Alfred streets, but there may be delays. NSW Police will facilitate access for people requiring the use of wheelchair accessible taxis.

## Road access restrictions

Motorists are advised to expect significant delays and disruptions within the Sydney CBD during intermittent road closures as VIPs are moved around the City and travel to and from the airport.

A restricted area will operate around Bridge, Macquarie and Phillip Streets from 4 - 9 September. Access is available for authorised vehicles through controlled access points. There is no on-street parking in the city during this time.

Special Event Clearways will also operate within the CBD during this time as well as along major arterial routes into and out of the City, so remember to check signs before parking as fines apply.

## What does this mean for public transport?



From Friday 7 to Sunday 9 September inclusive, **Circular Quay, Museum and St James stations will be closed.** Central, Town Hall, Martin Place and Wynyard stations will continue to operate as normal during this period. Visit [www.cityrail.info](http://www.cityrail.info) for APEC timetable information. The following arrangements will apply during APEC.

### From Sunday 2 September to Thursday 6 September

All CityRail services will operate to the normal timetable. Trackwork is taking place on the Newcastle & Central Coast Line. Pick up a trackwork brochure at your station or visit [www.cityrail.info](http://www.cityrail.info) for full details.

### Friday 7 September to Sunday 9 September

No services will operate around the City Circle. Circular Quay, Museum and St James stations will be closed.

### Eastern Suburbs & Illawarra, North Shore, Western, Northern, Carlingford, Olympic Park and Cumberland lines

#### 7 September

All services will run to a normal Saturday timetable.

#### 8/9 September

All services will run to a normal weekend timetable.

### Bankstown, Airport & East Hills and South lines

All services will start and terminate at Central Station.

#### 7 September

All services will run to a normal Saturday timetable.

#### 8/9 September

All services will run to a normal weekend timetable.

### Inner West Line

All services will start and terminate at North Sydney Station.

#### 7 September

All services will run to a normal Saturday timetable.

#### 8/9 September

All services will run to a normal weekend timetable.

## Hunter Line

### 7 September

All services will run to a normal weekday timetable.

### 8/9 September

All services will run to a normal weekend timetable.

## South Coast Line

### 7 September

Services will run to a weekday timetable with some changes to arrival and departure times as outlined below:

Services will depart stations on time between Nowra and Waterfall but will depart stations between Waterfall and Central approximately 1-4 minutes later than scheduled.

## Blue Mountains Line

#### Travelling towards Newcastle

Shuttle services between Gosford and Newcastle, and between Morisset and Newcastle will operate to the normal weekday timetable. Intercity services between Central, Wyong and Newcastle will operate to a weekend timetable with the following additional services:

### 8/9 September

All services will run to a normal weekend timetable.
